Class Updates

Creative Arts

This week in Creative Arts the 10-12 age campers made batik paintings to commemorate Juneteenth, a day to celebrate the end of slavery in America. The younger girls made flower crowns and the younger boys made Abstract Expressionist paintings in the style of famous painter Jackson Pollock. They also made cards, picture frames, drink holders, and key chains for the upcoming Father's Day holiday.

English Language Arts

The 5 year olds are tracing and writing letters, number words, and other basic words.

The 6-7 year olds are working on sounding out their vowels, and adding a consonant for a two and three letter word.

The 8-9 year olds are learning about prefixes. They are learning that a prefix can change both the meaning of a word and the word's identity.

The 10-12 year olds are learning about linking verbs. They are learning that a linking verb is a verb that links the subject to a noun or adjective in the predicate

Math

This week in Math, the 5-9 groups will explore numbers using place value and number lines. The 10-12 groups will explore numbers by classifying them according to the real number spectrum with a glimpse of imaginary numbers. Prevention With Ms. Marielle

5-7 girls and boys both went over keeping peace. 8-9 boys and girls went over conflict resolution, teasing, and bullying. They did role plays and saw a bullying video.

Prevention With Ms. Mary Lee

The 5-7 year olds learned about how to say “No” to bullying. They also learned about the harmful effects of tobacco and saying “No” to smoking.

The 8-9 year olds learned about how to use “I” statements to avoid conflicts. They worked on saying “No” to bullying and began smoking prevention.

The 10-12 year olds learned how to say “No” to bullying behaviors.
